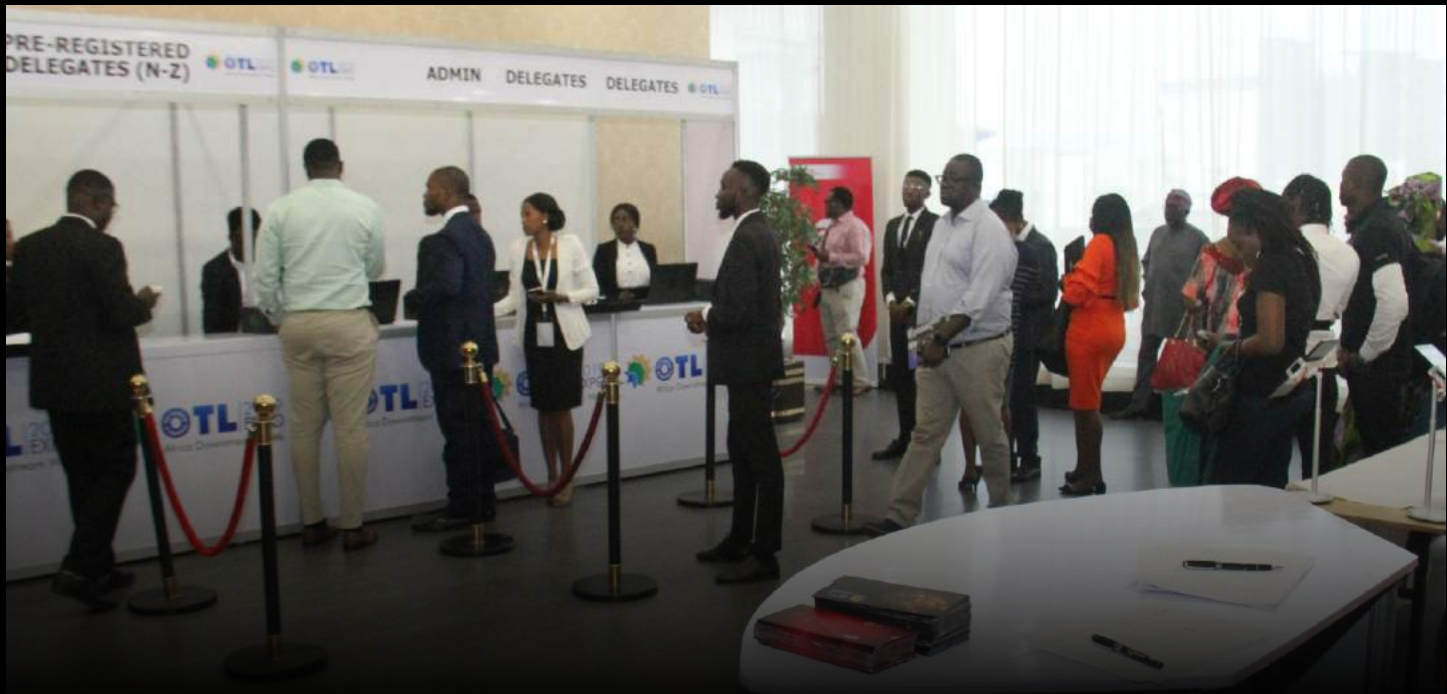

DOWNSTREAM INNOVATION CHALLENGE



We reintroduced the 'Downstream Innovation Challenge' at the 2019 OTL Africa Downstream Week encouraging students from tertiary institutions to develop technology-based solutions that address significant issues and operational efficiency in the downstream petroleum sector.

Three institutions of higher learning comprising; Covenant University, Rivers State University of Technology and University of Lagos emerged as finalists for the challenge with high expectations for a cash prize of \$3000.

At the pre-opening session, student representatives from Covenant University focused on "Block Chain in the Supply Chain Management System for Tracking & Verifying Lubricants", contestants from Rivers State University of Technology made their pitch around "Software Development for the Design of Atmosphere Distillation Column for Proposed Mini-refineries in Nigeria", while University of Lagos made a presentation on a "Tanker Monitoring and Safety System".

To evaluate the submissions and final presentations of the finalists was a panel of judges comprising; The past Director General, Nigerian Maritime Administration and Safety Agency (NIMASA) and shipping expert, Mr Temisan Omatseye, Mr Tony Ogbuigwe, CEO, Pejad Consulting and Mr. Abiodun Dada, Head of Oil and Gas, Access Bank Plc.
